SUBJECT: Isolation Payment Amount for 2017

Information to Share

The amount to be paid for the reimbursement to parents of isolated students is found in Wyo. Stat. 9-3-103 (a) (iii) "... If private vehicle transportation is used, reimbursement shall be as determined by the governor for the state and by the governing body of any other entity, based on a mileage allowance not to exceed the maximum nontaxable rates allowed by the Internal Revenue Service at the time of travel."

Per Governor Mead's memo dated December 15, 2016 the IRS set the rate **to 53.5 cents per mile** for travel effective January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. As a result, reimbursement for all types of vehicles used to provide isolation transportation to school shall not exceed 53.5 cents per mile for travel after January 1, 2017.
