Special Education, IDEA, and District Programs – Stephanie Zickefoose provided information regarding Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). She also reviewed the Individual Education Plan (IEP) process, areas of disabilities, Least Restrictive Environment (LRE), and Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE). Mrs. Zickefoose shared district data regarding special programs. Campbell County School District exceptional child specialists Dusty Evenson, Melissa Powell, Mary Williams, and Jacqueline McAdams shared information regarding the MAR program, Skills program, autism program, and the transition, of students with an IEP, from elementary school to secondary school.

504 – Lori Townsend informed the board about 504 eligibility criteria and the implementation process. Ms. Townsend also reviewed differences between a 504 and IEP. Some employees qualify for 504 consideration which is handled through the human resourced department.

Student Teachers – Dr. Reznicek went over the district’s practice regarding student teachers, mentor teachers, staff development, administrators, and human resources. Mrs. Durgin and Chairman Ochs asked about the possibility of providing student teachers with an induction that would provide some training on district programs.
