Dr. Brown listed the topics that would be presented at the meeting: 1) Opportunity for board members to ask questions regarding items on the Consent Agenda, 2) Board Committee Reports, 3) Food Items with Red Dye, 3) CCSD Supervision & Evaluation, and 4) Virtual Classes zero and eighth hr

Consent Agenda Questions – There were no questions on the Consent Agenda items.

Board Committee Reports – Mrs. Hladky attended the STEM open house at Conestoga. The students were excited to show their parents the lab. Chairman Ochs is pleased that the STEM labs are well received by the community.

Chairman Ochs reported that Mrs. Bell is going to the Capitol Renovation Tour in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Food Items with Red Dye – Bryan Young provided a handout which listed the food items that nutrition services offers which contain red dye. Nutrition Services will accommodate with an alternative lunch that does not have red dye if a parent requests that for their child. If there is a substitution made for a student meal, a form needs to be completed by the doctor, and the school keeps it on file

CCSD Supervision & Evaluation – Dr. Larry Reznicek provided the handout C.C.S.D. Supervision & Evaluation - A Framework for Teaching by Charlotte Danielson and went through the process of supervision and evaluation of staff. Dr. Ayers shared that he is responsible for principal evaluations.

Virtual Classes Zero or Eighth hour – Dr. Brown shared there are two virtual schools in Wyoming for secondary students – Connection Academy in the Big Horn Basin and K-12 in Niobrara County. A suggestion was made to gather information on student interest in a zero or eighth hour elective virtual class. Dr. Lawrence provided the suggestion that guidance counselors assist the students by asking them what their future goals are, and guide them toward electives that align.
