Dr. Brown listed the topics that would be presented at the meeting: 1) Opportunity for board members to ask questions regarding items on the Consent Agenda, 2) Board Committee Reports, 3) Suicide Prevention, and 4) Enrollment.

Consent Agenda Questions – There were no questions regarding Consent Agenda items.

Board Committee Reports:

Wyoming School Board Association (WSBA) Representative – Mr. Foreman reported that WSBA met and made revisions to their mission and vision statement. Their focus is on education issues in Wyoming.

Legislative Forum - Dr. Brown reported on the Legislative Forum held February 25 and 26 in Cheyenne. Mrs. Bell reported on the tour of the Capital Building refurbishment.

Enrollment – Dr. Ayers reported on kindergarten enrollment which currently stands at 629 children enrolled for kindergarten for next year. Dr. Ayers also reported that secondary principals will be meeting with their staff to discuss the pros and cons of the seven-period day, and he will report back to the board on that issue.

Suicide Prevention – Kip Farnum and Lori Townsend with Student Support Services reported on suicide prevention. A handout was shared with the board as well as information about risk factors, protective factors, youth suicide data, and youth suicide strategies. Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR) training will be provided to the board at a future dinner meeting.
