

Campbell County School District Board of Trustees Special Dinner Meeting  
Tuesday, July 18, 2018, at 5:15 pm

Dr. Ayers listed the topics that would be presented at the meeting: 1) Opportunity for board members to ask questions regarding items on the Consent Agenda, 2) Board Committee Updates, 3) Review of public hearings regarding Policy 5300 and Administrative Regulation 5300-R, Activities Participation; and Policy 5035 and Administrative Regulation 5035-R, Attendance Areas and Attendance Area Change Requests, 4) The Penny Drive, 5) Juuling, 6) Academic Reports, and 7) Budget Preview. All topics will be addressed as time permits.

Consent Agenda Questions – There were no questions regarding Consent Agenda items.

Board Committee Updates – There were no board committee updates.

The Penny Drive – Dr. Ayers shared that he had been contacted to see if the school district would be interested in having a Penny Drive to support the Gillette College Foundation and the Power your Future Campaign. The board was supportive of allowing schools to raise funds for a specific project such as the expansion of the college library as long as school administrators understand participation in this fund raiser is completely optional.

Academic Reports – Dr. Ayers shared that this will be the first year for WyTOPP, and those results will not be available for presentation to the board until the November meeting. The board was in favor of having principals present academic reports at a retreat in January rather than at board meetings.

Review of public hearings regarding Policy 5300 and Administrative Regulation 5300-R, Activities Participation; and Policy 5035 and Administrative Regulation 5035-R, Attendance Areas and Attendance Area Change Requests – Dr. Reznicek provided feedback from the public hearings which were held on June 14 and June 21.

Juuling – Dr. Ayers and Mr. Eisenhauer presented information and shared videos on Juuling. The boards concern over this trend will be shared with administrators at the back to school meeting.

Budget Preview – This topic was not discussed due to a lack of time.

The meeting adjourned at 6:18 pm with no action taken by the board.
