Dr. Ayers listed the topics that would be presented at the meeting: 1) Opportunity for board members to ask questions regarding items on the Consent Agenda, 2) Board Committee Reports, 3) Chapter 29: Evaluation Systems for District and School Leaders and Other Certified Personnel.

Consent Agenda Questions – There were no Consent Agenda questions.

Chapter 29: Evaluation Systems for District and School Leaders and Other Certified Personnel – Larry Reznicek presented information regarding Chapter 29 evaluation requirements for certified personnel, district leaders, and school leaders. Chapter 29 rules are being revised following the passage of SF36/SEA31. Administration feels the district's current evaluation system for certified personnel contains the new standards; however, they will review samples of evaluations which will be presented at the Wyoming School Boards Association meeting in November. The district is considering submitting their current evaluation system to the State Board of Education for review and feedback. By February 1, 2019 the district must notify the State Board of Education if they plan to use a state-defined evaluation or their locally designed evaluation.
