 - d. *All educators aware of new standards based on “Indian Education For All” act and are prepared for any changes

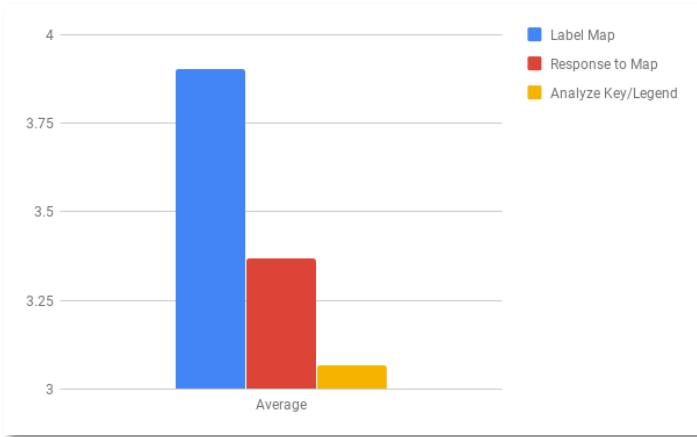

 - b. ACT-Prep Data

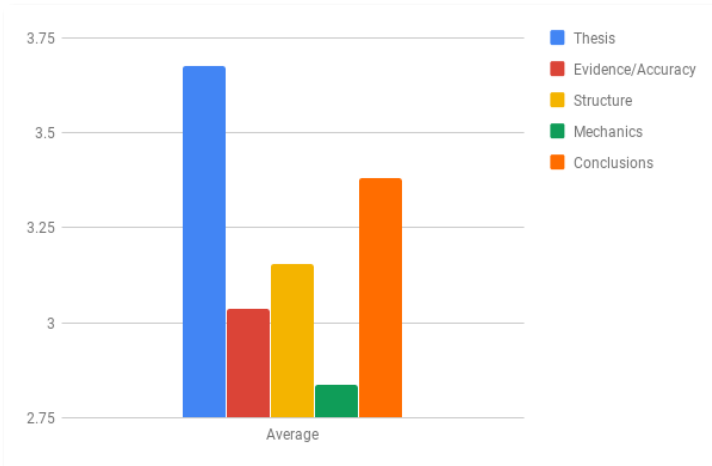
- IV. Unique Opportunities and Celebrations
