Participation Requirements for 2018-2019 Academic Year

Minimum ACT composite of 23 or a recommendation from school personnel is required for enrollment in all transfer courses.*

*Students younger than juniors may enroll with written permission from their building Principal.

Maximum of 6 credit hours per semester for the first semester of participation.

Maximum of 16 credit hours per semester for any successive semester of participation.

Available to qualified juniors and seniors**

**Students entering their junior year must have accumulated at least 16 high school credits.

**Students entering their junior year must enroll in Junior English at their high school.

**Sophomores are eligible with permission of high school Principal.

Non-transfer (CTE) courses are included in this program and qualifications do not include an ACT score but do require previous enrollment in appropriate CTE courses at their high school.

Students who are successful their first semester may take their entire course load subsequently at the college.

Students may enroll in the Pronghorn Advantage program at the beginning of any qualifying semester.

*Students must be enrolled before the first day of the college semester start.

Day, online and evening Gillette College courses are all available for this program.

Participating students will be awarded appropriate released time at the high school for participation in the dual enrollment program at Gillette College.

Participating students will receive the same grade for the course on his/her high school transcript as they receive for the course at Gillette College.

Any/all "special circumstances" must be approved by the building Principal.

Award of this scholarship may only be granted by the BOCHES director.

Any student receiving a grade of "D", "F", "W", or "I" in any dual enrollment course will not be awarded further Panther Advantage scholarships unless approval is granted by the BOCHES administrator.
